The existing Church of St. Francis Xavier was completed in 1917 and at that time was not designed to provide for the needs of handicap members. WCL was contracted to provide the Church with a design that included handicap accessibility by an elevator, a handicap accessible restroom and direct access to the Worship area and meeting hall from the parking area. The Church's Building Committee highly stressed the need for the addition design to maintain the architectural aesthetics of the existing church design.
